General Info

It is with great pleasure that the European Academy of Religion announces its third Annual Conference, which will take place in Bologna between Monday, June 22nd and Thursday, June 25th 2020. Fscire (www.fscire.it) will be the organizing institution. The scientific program will be composed of keynote lectures and working sessions (panels, book presentations).

Hereby EuARe opens the Call for Proposals, with the following novelties:

- Starting from this year, we open only a **Call for Panels**. A panel can be
 - a) **closed** (with the choice of speakers already settled) or
 - b) **open** (therefore connected to its own Call for Papers).

In order to be accepted, <u>panels must be composed of at least 3 participants</u>, 1 chair and at least 2 speakers.

- Once all the Panels proposals are evaluated and proponents informed about the acceptance or rejection, a **Call for Papers** is opened. Papers are only allowed to be proposed **within** the open calls published on the website. <u>Spare papers won't be accepted</u>.
- **Author Meets Critique** (AMC) sessions have a defined slot of 1 hour. AMC proponents must identify the speakers and discussants of their session and organise it accordingly.
- We propose a new type of session: **Publishers Meet Scholars**. We invite publishers to take this opporutnity to create a space where the needs of scholars and publishers can meet, for example, by presenting collections in their editorial line or addressing scholars with suggestions and advices on publishing issues, questions and processes. If you are a publishers and would liek to explore this possibility, feel free to contact the EuARe Secretariat (eu_are@fscire.it): we will do our best to support you while preparing the proposal.
- **Slots equal to hours**. If you ask for one slot you are therefore asking for one effective hour of the program. In every hour/slot the suggested amount of speakers is 3.
- Differently from previous years, the only accepted language for panels and papers is **English**. As
 inclusiveness has always been a major focal point for EuARe, it has been decided to unify proposals
 language in order to allow every participant to take part in discussions and panels throughout the
 entirety of the Conference.

Call for Panels

EuARe opens the 2020 Annual Conference Call for Proposals. Starting from this year, we open only a **Call for Panels**. You can submit your proposal here: http://forms.fscire.it/forms/submit/panel20/

A panel can be

- a) **closed** (does not accept papers. Speakers are contacted and selected by the proponent)
- b) **open** (accepts papers sent through the submission procedure. Speakers are chosen by the proponent among the proposals received).

In order to be accepted, panels must be composed of at least 3 participants, 1 chair and at least 2 speakers.

Proponents will be notified about the outcome of their submission between 15/09/19 and 15/10/19.

Accepted **closed panels** have time until 31/01/20 to define their asset and communicate the definitive list of speakers (Name, Surname and Affiliation) together with the definitive titles of presentations.

Accepted **open panels** have their call published on the EuARe website by 15/10/19.

Proponents must present the final version of the panel — comprehensive of panel title and abstract, speakers' names, surnames and affiliations, papers titles — by 31/01/20.

After the publication of the draft program, proponents and speakers are allowed to request changes regarding date and time for panels until 15/03/20.

Keep in mind that **slots equal to hours**. If you ask for one slot you are therefore asking for one effective hour. In every hour/slot the suggested amount of speakers is 3.

Differently from previous years, the only accepted language for panels and papers is **English**. As inclusiveness has always been a major focal point for EuARe, it has been decided to unify proposals language in order to allow every participant to take part in discussions and panels throughout the entirety of the Conference.

- 6. An email address to which paper proposals should be sent (if different from proponent)

Proponent [First Name], [Last Name], [Contact Email], [Panel Title] and [Panel Abstract] boxes are not filled-out

1 Chair is not selected (You will be able to change it later on when defining the final details of the panel)

For <u>closed panels</u>, at least 3 different people's details are not filled-out (at least 3 speakers or 2 speakers plus the proponent if he acts as chair)

Call for Author Meets Critique

EuARe opens the 2020 Annual Conference Call for Proposals and with it, a Call for Author Meets Critique (AMC). You can submit your proposal here: http://forms.fscire.it/forms/submit/author20/

Authors are invited to present their books, finding discussants and speakers that intervene in the one-hour long session and organising the time accordingly. In the allocated time for AMC session, EuARe suggests a number of maximum 4 people.

In order to be accepted, panels must be composed of at least 3 participants, 1 chair and at least 2 speakers.

The Call for AMC closes on 15th September 2019 and proponents will be notified about the outcome of their submission between 15/09/19 and 15/10/19.

AMC proponents have time until by 31/01/20 to define their asset and communicate the definitive list of speakers (Name, Surname and Affiliation).

After the publication of the draft program, proponents are allowed to request changes regarding date and time for panels until 15/03/20.

Every AMC session corresponds to one slot and one hour.

Differently from previous years, the only accepted language for sessions is **English**. As inclusiveness has always been a major focal point for EuARe, it has been decided to unify proposals language in order to allow every participant to take part in discussions and panels throughout the entirety of the Conference.

Before starting the submission process, make sure to have the following information at hand:

- 2. An abstract of up to 1500 characters spaces included (the system won't accept longer abstracts)
- 3. The full details of the book presented
